**Project Location (County of Riverside):** The Project site is located in Pushawalla Canyon within the unincorporated community of Indio Hills, CA. The Project site is located within the southwest corner of APN 750-130-005.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS-RIV-29790-R6, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, Coachella Valley Water District.

The Project includes impacts to streams associated with the construction of two 1,000,000-gallon aboveground welded-steel tanks, Reservoirs 4711-3 and 4711-4, followed by the demolition of the two existing 100,000-gallon aboveground bolted-steel tanks, Reservoirs 4711-1 and 4711-2.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on December 14, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
