**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The project consists of the construction and operation of a 54,476-square-foot (SF) church/sanctuary building and a 71,010 SF, two-level parking garage and surface parking areas on an approximately 6-acre vacant site. The proposed project would include a 900-seat sanctuary space with accessory uses (i.e., Sunday school classrooms, offices, and a multi-purpose room/gym), and various site improvements, such as circulation, landscaping, and utility connections which are described below. Of the 900 seats, 587 seats would be fixed in place and 3,690 SF would accommodate the remaining non-fixed seats. Congregation gatherings would primarily occur on Sundays; small group activities may occur during the weekdays or on Saturdays. No primary educational school spaces are proposed as part of the project. The project would require City approval of a Community Plan Amendment (CPA) to modify the Navajo Community Plan, Planned Development Permit (PDP), Site Development Permit (SDP) and various easement vacations. (LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Portion of Lot 67 of Rancho Mission of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, as described in grant deed November 3, 1975 at document 76-306249) **The site is not included on any Government Code listing of hazardous waste sites**.
