PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Site Approval application for a farm services business to provide irrigation pipes and equipment to agricultural operations be completed in 2 phases over 5 years. Phase 1 includes the construction of a 240-square-foot modular office, and grading for an approximately 14-acre outdoor irrigation pipe storage area. Phase 2 includes the construction of a 5,000-square-foot building to be used as a shop. The business is proposed to operate Monday through Friday, 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., with 5 to 10 employees. A request to modify the project area surfacing has been submitted with this application. The project site is not under a Williamson Act Contract.

The Property is zoned AG-80 (General Agriculture, 80-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is A/G (General Agriculture).

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located on the northeast corner of West State Route 4 Highway and John Turk Rd., Stockton. (APN/Address: 162-130-05 / 3195 W. State Route 4, Stockton) (Supervisorial District: 3)

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: This is a Notice of Intent to adopt a Negative Declaration for this project as described.
