**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SBR-19991-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to SimonCRE, LLC, as represented by Joshua Simon.

The Project is limited to the construction of a 36-inch diameter (9.4 cubic feet per second capacity) storm drainpipe that will discharge stormwater runoff and surface flows into the San Bernardino County flood control channel after settling in the proposed ponding basin.
