General Plan Amendment and Rezoning from Historic Combining, General Office, and

Community Commercial to Planned Development (PD) to construct a six-story residential mixed-use building with 53 condominium units and a 2,000 square-foot ground floor retail/restaurant space. The proposal also includes four townhomes behind

the mixed-use building.

As authorized by the City of Santa Clara as a Lead Agency, the City is seeking the views of responsible agencies and the public as to the scope and content of the environmental information that should be considered for inclusion in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the proposed project. The project description, location, and potential environmental effects are contained in the materials provided in the form of a Notice of Preparation (NOP).
