<u>Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:</u>

The purpose of the Project is to reduce the frequency and severity of collisions in the project limits and improve safety for the travelling public. The project will realign a 1/2 -mile section of roadway on Highway 299 in Shasta County between post miles 44.3 - 44.9 and make the following improvements: improve alignment consistency, improve curve safety, increase sight distance, provide 4- to 8- foot paved shoulders, and increase the clear recovery zone.
