

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION Elk Grove Great Nature Park Project

A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the following project has been prepared by Cosumnes Community Services District pursuant to the guidelines and procedures for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The project site is located within two Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APN): 125-0120-021 and 125-0120-025. The project site is located at the southeast corner of Elk Grove Boulevard and Williamson Drive.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Elk Grove Great Nature Park is a proposed 2.5-acre park to be located at 8820 Elk Grove Boulevard in the City of Elk Grove. The proposed project would preserve the existing wetlands and add new trees, American Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant accessible pathways, ramps, and bridges, rain gardens, new bicycle parking spaces, solar panels over parking areas, a children's nature play area, and new gardens. A future phase of the project includes a small Nature Center building that would allow for education, training, events, and community activities. Existing parking areas would be reconfigured.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** The Initial Study/MND will be publicly available on Tuesday, November 9, 2021. Comments on this document will be received from Tuesday, November 9, 2021 through Thursday, December 9, 2021.
