The scope of work includes site preparation, removal of hazardous material, remove and replace damaged pavement and HMA dike, striping, pavement markers, pavement markings, traffic control, and incidental work.

Right-of-Way

All work occurred within Caltrans right-of-way.

Borrow/Disposal

Grinded asphalt concrete (AC) material was sent back to the AC plant.

Consultation/Coordination

Based on the scope of work and due to the nature of the project, consultation or coordination was not required.

Permits

Based on the scope of work, regulatory permits were not required.

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
