Rock Creek Meadow Shasta Crayfish Habitat Augmentation Project Title:

Project Location - Specific: Township 35N, Range 4E, Section 5

Cassel, CA

Project Location - County: Shasta County

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Project purpose is to create additional habitat for the federally and state-listed endangered Shasta crayfish (Pacifastacus fortis). The project goal is to ensure there is adequate high-quality and contiguous habitat to provide for a viable, self-sustaining Shasta crayfish population in the refuge habitat. Placing gravel and cobbles in the streambed in the restored meadow stream section will augment the current breeding. rearing, and sheltering habitat for Shasta crayfish.

Up to 40 cubic yards of pre-washed gravel will be hand placed into select portions of the restored Rock Creek channel to increase gravel depth to approximately 3 inches at those locations. Placement will be done by filling 5-gallon buckets with gravel, carrying them to the stream bank by hand or with a cart or wheelbarrow, placing them on a small work barge, which will be guided to the desired placement locations using ropes and pulleys temporarily set up along the banks.
