

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to rehabilitate or replace five culvert systems on State Route 1 from postmile (PM) 85.09 to 88.95 between Rockport and Leggett in Mendocino County. The purpose of this is to improve drainage systems and reduce erosion to protect the structural integrity of State Route 1. The project is needed because the culverts are severely damaged or have failed, resulting in insufficient drainage capacity causing roadway flooding and embankment erosion which could potentially lead to roadway failure.
