The City of Blythe (City) will be the Lead Agency and will prepare an Environmental Impact Report pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (14 California Code of Regulations Section 15060 and 15063) for the proposed Edelweiss Sustainable Farms project (Project) proposed by Edelweiss Sustainable Farms, LLC. The Project is located south of Hobsonway, north of Interstate 10, and approximately 0.25 miles west of South Carlton Avenue.
