The general plan land use designations of the project site consist of Rural Residential A combined with Mining Resource Buffer (RA-MRB) and Mixed Use combined with Mining Resource Buffer (MU-MRB). The northern 2.93-acre parcel (APN 307-170-012) is in the Mixed Use combined with Mineral Resource Buffer (MU-MRB) zone district and the southern 2.73-acre parcel (APN 307-170-013) is in the Public Facilities combined with Mineral Resource Buffer (PF-MRB) zone district.
