PROJECT TITLE: High Road Detour

LOCATION: Hollister Hills State Vehicular Recreation Area **COUNTY:** San Benito

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Change the start of both High and Sage Roads at Lower Ranch in Hollister Hills State Vehicular Recreation Area to change this 2-way traffic thoroughfare into a single direction access route and eliminate sharp, unsafe turns. Project will:

- Use hand tools to cut back vegetation and a dozer and excavator to widen and improve LeRoy's Trail by 2 feet for approximately 850 feet to make it a drivable connector between High and Sage Roads;
- Excavate four (4) 12 inch diameter x 36 inch deep holes;
- Install two (2) 6 inch diameter x 8 feet long gate posts to install a gate to close off the existing entrance at High Road to public access;
- Move the new start to Sage Road which runs parallel beneath High Road;
- Close off the old entrance to Sage Road and restore to natural contours and cover with downed vegetation and planted with native stock; and
- Install two (2) new signs, 6 inch diameter x 8 feet long, each at Sage and High Roads to inform the public of the closed and new/rerouted road alignment.
