Project Location: The Project is located at Yuba River and four of its unnamed tributaries along State Route (SR) 80 in the County of Placer and the County of Nevada, State of California. The post miles (PM) for this Project are PLA-80 PM 68.45, 69.09, 69.24, 69.54, and NEV-80 R2.63R.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-36867-R2), pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation. The Project includes replacing a culvert, extending one culvert, repairing two culverts, and cleaning one culvert at various locations on SR-80 as part of a roadway rehabilitation involving roadway widening on the eastbound land with a trucking climbing lane creation. One culvert will have small mammal shelving installed to facilitate wildlife crossing. Clearing, grubbing, excavation, backfilling, grading, compacting, concrete work, and RSP placement will be done in the stream channels and their associated riparian habitat.
