To control vegetation, herbicides are sprayed along aqueduct roads, fence-lines, bar/v-ditches, and buildings. Plant debris is also removed and burned at designated burn sites. The vegetation control program extends, on both sides of the aqueduct, from MP 172.58 to MP 293.45 of the State Water Project and from MP 0.00 to MP 14.84 of the Coastal Branch.
