

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from January 14, 2022 to February 14, 2022 If there are no major comments or requests for a hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.



WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to cold plane 0.25 inch of existing asphalt concrete pavement and replace it with Type A hot mix after sealing cracks and repairing failed localized areas. Caltrans also plans to overlay the entire roadway with 0.10 foot of Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt Gap-Graded Bonded Wearing Course and build shoulder backing. Additionally, Caltrans proposes to upgrade Transportation Management Strategy elements and culverts within the project limits.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a public hearing.
