PROJECT TITLE: Summit Road Vegetation Management

LOCATION: Mount Diablo State Park COUNTY: Contra Costa

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Clear vegetation from within up to 10 feet from each side of the Summit Road shoulders in Mount Diablo State Park to improve sight clearance for vehicles, improve fuel break function of Summit Road, and enhance the scenic vistas of Summit Road. Work will use hand or power tools to complete the following:

- Clear vegetation that encroaches into the roadway prism, thin remaining trees and shrubs, and prune retained vegetation to remove ladder fuels;
- Lop and scatter twigs and small-diameter material on site
- Remove and dispose of larger downed woody material using an air curtain burner, chipper, and/or pile burn; and
- Use mower to cut existing grasses to 4 inches high or less.
