**REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:** The proposed project involves the construction of 4 charging stations within the existing community center parking lot will not result in adverse environmental impacts. Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible expansion of existing use. Class 3 consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures, installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures, where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. Class 4 consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. Class 11 consists of construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to small parking lots. The proposed project, as described above, meets these criteria.
