The County has prepared this Notice of Intent to Adopt a MND to provide an opportunity for input from public agencies, organizations, and interested parties on the environmental analysis addressing the potential effects of the proposed project.

PROJECT TITLE: Tentative Parcel Map for Anthony G. and Renette R. Symmes Family Trust (TPM21-0009).

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located on the south side of Durham-Dayton Highway approximately 250 feet west of Stanford Lane, at 2125 Durham-Dayton Highway, east of Durham. Assessor Parcel Numbers: 040-200-096 and a portion of 040-200-097.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Tentative Parcel Map to divide a 5.93 acre property into three parcels (1.52, 1.89, and 2.52 acres). The project parcel is developed with a residence and accessory structures. The project parcel fronts on Durham-Dayton Highway, a publicly-maintained paved road. Future residences will be served by individual wells until Durham Irrigation District water is available. The parcels will be served by individual septic systems. The parcels will be served a proposed cul-de-sac within a 60-foot easement.
