**Vesting Tentative Tract 934:** A request by Precision Civil Engineering, Inc. to subdivide 36.48 acres into 161 single-family residential lots in the R-L-5 Low-Density Residential zone district.

**Location:** The project is located at the southeast corner of 13th Avenue and Grangeville Boulevard (APN 009-050-001 through -005).

Based on an Initial Study, the Community Development Department has determined that the project described above would not have significant adverse impacts on the environment with the incorporation of mitigation measures.
