**PROJECT TITLE**: Kiln Trail Bridge Replacement

**LOCATION**: Limekiln State Park

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Install a new Kiln Trail bridge at Limekiln State Park to replace the bridge destroyed during the 2020 Dolan Fire by a fallen redwood tree. The new bridge will be placed approximately 30 feet downstream from original bridge site. Work will:

- construct a rock wall and approach steps;
- install a new 55 -foot long wood gluelam bridge with redwood decking and handrails;
- construct a 40-foot trail reroute to connect the new bridge to the existing trail.

Best management practices including silt fencing, straw wattles, and woven geo-textile fabric will be used to prevent any soil or other materials from entering the creek.
