The project proposes to construct two 165,000 square foot five-story office buildings totaling 330,000 square feet; a five-level parking garage and surface lots providing a total of 980 parking spaces; and site and public-right-of-way improvements. The project proposes to construct new five-foot wide sidewalks along the site's frontage on Oakmead Village Court and Central Expressway, which would connect to the existing sidewalk on Bowers Avenue. The proposed office buildings would be 87.5 feet tall at the top of the roof screen and the parking structure would be 63.5 feet at the top of the elevator tower. A more detailed description is attached to this form.
