Parcel 2 to contain 4.5 acres. Parcel 3 to contain 4.6 acres. Parcel 4 to contain 4.5 acres. This parcel is accessed off of the east side of N. Bruella Rd., Acampo. This parcel is not under a Williamson Act Contract.

The Property is zoned AL-5 (Limited Agriculture, 5-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is A/L (Limited Agriculture).
