PLANNING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION OF APPROVAL FOR <u>REZONE APPLICATION NO. PLN2021-0098 – A & R MORTUARY SERVICES</u> - Request to rezone a 9,486 ± square-foot parcel from Planned Development (P-D) (276) to a new P-D, to allow a mortuary establishment in addition to the low-traffic generating light industrial uses currently permitted. The project site is located at 5434 and 5436 Pirrone Road, between the MID Lateral No. 8 Canal and Pirrone Court, in the Community of Salida.
