Project Location (include county): The project is located on an unnamed ephemeral tributary to Black Butte Lake at T23N/R05W section 32, and unnamed tributaries to Jewett Creek at T24N/R04W section 14 and T24N/R04W section 13 in Tehama County; Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, Sehorn Creek and Henleyville U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangles.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SHA-25223-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Stephen Soske.

On May 18, 2021, the State Water Resources Control Board performed a site inspection of water storage facilities owned by the Permittee in Tehama County. On June 16, 2021, the Division of Water Rights issued a letter detailing findings of noncompliance resulting from the inspections which requires reduction in storage capacity of storage reservoirs located on tributaries to Black Butte Lake and Jewett Creek. The proposed Projects consist of construction intended to modify the capacity and improve infrastructure associated with existing water storage impoundments.
