The proposed removal of the portable classrooms, replacement with new portable buildings, building expansion, modernization, new lunch shelter, play structures, outdoor learning space and other site improvements are exempt from CEQA under Class 2, Replacement or Reconstruction (Section 15302). The new buildings and facilities will be located within the school campus, on the same site as the buildings and facilities to be replaced. The new buildings consist of new portable buildings, serving the same purpose as the replaced structure. School capacity would not be affected, and enrollment is expected to decline over the next ten years. Since the new structures and improvements are located on the same site and have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the replaced structure, the project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15302.		
The proposed project was also reviewed for possible exceptions under Section 15300.2 and found that the exceptions do not apply.		
Additionally, the proposed project is statutorily exempt because it is consistent with CEQA Section 21080.35, which provides that solar energy systems installed on the roof of an existing building or on an existing parking lot.
