**DOCUMENT TITLE:** Replacement Well Project (Project)

**PROJECT LOCATION:** Road 164 and Avenue 164, unincorporated Tulare County.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project. The Project includes the drilling, casing, and development of a new groundwater well (Well No. 4), including the installation of a water lubricated pump, electric motor, chlorine disinfection system, and a hydropneumatic tank for pressure control purposes. On site improvements include fencing and site surfacing, and the installation of an emergency standby generator. Transmission pipelines will be installed to connect the new well to the existing water distribution system. Other off-site improvements include provision of utility electrical power to the well site and surfacing of an access road from the well site to a public road.

**PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT:** The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on June 26, 2023. The Woodville Public Utility District will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.

4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
