Request to establish an agricultural service establishment on a 39.64± acre parcel in the General Agriculture (A-2-40) zoning district. The proposal includes installation of micronutrient mineral batching equipment within and adjacent to an existing 120,000 square-foot agricultural storage building for the purpose of mixing nutrients for incorporation into dairy feed. The facility will be owned, operated by, and serve a small group of dairymen and industry professionals with Stanislaus and surrounding counties for the purpose of decreasing internal costs and to mix mineral blends to serve the needs of each individual dairy.
