The Sobrante Water Treatment Plant (SOWTP) primarily serves customers in El Sobrante, Richmond, Pinole, Hercules, Rodeo, Crockett, and San Pablo. The purpose of the SOWTP Reliability Improvements Project is to increase the treatment capacity of the SOWTP to reliably meet future demand, treat additional Folsom South Canal Connection water during droughts, reduce disinfection by-products, and improve treatment processes. The Project includes construction of new facilities and would be divided into a Phase 1 and Phase 2 sequencing, to meet near-term and long-term demand, respectively. Phase 1 improvements would increase SOWTP capacity to 60 million gallons per day (MGD), and Phase 2 improvements would increase capacity further to 80 MGD. The Project also included demolition of the existing wash water settling basins, reclaim pumping plant, solids detention basins, and related vaults, mechanical, and electrical equipment, after completion of Phase 1.
