## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The Truckee Donner Public Utility District (District) proposes to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act for the project listed below:

PROPOSED PROJECT: Pioneer Trail Pipeline and Pump Station project; a pump station and pipeline to supply utilities to the Truckee Donner Subdivision.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located in the Town of Truckee in Nevada County, California, north of U.S. Interstate 80. The project site consists of a 1.7-mile-long pipeline that begins on Northwoods Boulevard and moves east until reaching the intersection of Comstock Drive and Pioneer Trail. The project would pass through five Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APN) including: 019-400-028; 019-400-029; 019-400-031; 018-010-051; and 018-010-052 and is approximately located at latitude/ longitude -120.194086, 39.336378.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Pioneer Trail Pipeline and Pump Station project (proposed project) would construct a single pump station and a 1.7-mile-long pipeline to supply water, electrical and communications utilities to the Truckee Donner Subdivision. The pipeline alignment would run from Northwoods Boulevard and terminate at the intersection of Comstock Drive and Pioneer Trail. The pipeline alignment would be constructed on the paved Tout Creek Trail, along disturbed utility corridors, to an existing bridge that crosses Trout Creek Trail, and along existing dirt utility roads. The pump station would be located on the eastern end of the pipeline alignment near the intersection of Comstock Drive and Pioneer Trail. Project construction is anticipated to start in June 2022 and would require approximately 7-16 months to complete.

REVIEW PERIOD: The District is providing a 30-day public review period for the Draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration. The review period begins on March 14, 2022 and ends on April 12, 2022.
