- Environmental reevaluation will be required if the scope of the project changes to include additional areas or activities, or if previously unknown cultural or other sensitive resources are discovered. Contact the Environmental Office if project changes occur or sensitive resources discovered.
- Contact the Environmental Office to attend the pre-construction meeting.

Cultural:

- If cultural materials are discovered at the job site, do not disturb the resources and immediately:
 - 1. Stop all work within a 60foot radius of discovery
 - 2. Protect the discovery area
 - 3. Notify the Engineer
 - 4. The Department Investigates. Do not move cultural materials or take them from the job site. Retain a qualified archaeologist to assess the significance of the find. Do not resume work within the discovery area until authorized.
- If human remains are discovered, State Health and Safety Code Section 7050.5 states that further disturbances and activities shall cease in any area or nearby area suspected to overlie remains, and the County coroner contacted. Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 5097.98. If the remains are thought to be Native American, the coroner will notify the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) who will then notify the Most Likely Descendent (MLD). At the same time the landowner will work with the MLD on the respectful treatment and disposition of the remains. Further provisions of PRC 5097.98 are to be followed as applicable.
- Location 2 (PM 24.36) will require a Caltrans District 10 qualified Architectural Historian and/or Archaeologist to install marked, wooden stakes along the existing rock walls that are near the project limits. The contractor must contact the Caltrans District 10 Environmental Office thirty (30) days prior to the start of construction to schedule the installation. The stakes will be installed approximately five (5) feet apart along the existing sensitive area. No constructions activities are permitted past the marked stakes unless previously coordinated with the Caltrans D10 Environmental Office. Standard Special Provision (SSP) 14-6.03A shall be included in the construction contract.
- Location 2 (PM 24.36) will require Architectural History and/or Archaeological monitoring during all construction related activities. The contractor must contact the Caltrans District 10 Environmental Office thirty (30) days prior to the start of construction to request the monitor. No constructions activities are permitted without the monitor unless previously coordinated with the Caltrans D10

Environmental Office. Caltrans Standard Special Provision (SSP) 14-6.03A shall be included in the construction contract.

Biology:

• If construction will occur during bird nesting season (February 1 through September 30), contact the Environmental Office at least one month prior to the start of construction to schedule a pre-construction bird survey. Caltrans Standard Special Provision (SSP) 14-6.03A regarding protective buffer radii shall be included in the construction contract. If an active migratory bird nest is observed, a 100-foot protective buffer will be established around the nest until the young have fledged. For hawks, a 300-foot protective buffer will be established. No work is allowed within those buffer limits until the young have fledged the nest and until authorized by the Caltrans District 10 Environmental Office.
