DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The project will remove fire-damaged debris and hazardous materials from the Sepulveda Adobe site located at Malibu Creek State Park. The Sepulveda Adobe will remain in a "ruin-like" state for interpretation of the historic structure after the 2018 Woolsey Fire that caused its destruction. Once cleaned of all debris, the facility will not be accessible to the public, and accessed by Parks staff on a limited basis.

To determine what to remove and what to clean/salvage, DPR conducted both historic structures and hazardous material studies after the fire. Removal includes both building material and soil/vegetation surrounding the building.
