Fuel management practices are proposed in the Bluebird Canyon area and along Park Avenue primarily within the City of Laguna Beach, with a small portion of fuel management zone (FMZ) 17 within unincorporated County of Orange. Project activities would be conducted in accordance with the approved Treatment Protocols for Fuel Modification Zones Subject to Coastal Development Permitting prepared by the Laguna Beach Fire Department. Hand crews, with the option of goat-grazing, would reduce vegetation load in 100-foot-wide sections within FMZs 17 and 18 for a total of approximately 17.8 acres. Hand crews would reduce vegetation within a 50-foot zone on either side of Park Avenue (FMZ 22) for a total of approximately 7.2 acres. The majority of roots of perennial plants would remain, and native vegetation waste would be mulched and left on site to minimize erosion. Non-native vegetation waste would be transported to a green waste recycling facility or landfi

Sensitive biological resources would be protected through the establishment of exclusion areas.
