**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of the Project:** The Rotelli Private Dump (Site) is a former burn dump located on two parcels that total approximately 20-acres. The extent of the waste footprint has been visually estimated to be approximately 3 acres in size and is situated on steep slopes. The property is currently owned by two members of the Rotelli family and/or their Trust.

The Program's contractor will install approximately 3,400 feet of a combination of chainlink and barbed wire fencing along the property boundaries to prevent both pedestrian and vehicular access to the Site. The installation of the security fencing includes the limited removal of solid waste debris and vegetation clearing along the fence line. Soil generated from post holes will be stockpiled on site and covered with 6-mil poly and sandbags.

The project is an action by a State regulatory agency, as authorized by state law and regulation, to perform work required to restore and protect the environment.

The following categorical exemptions apply to the project:

- Class 1 exemption, Title 14 California Code of Regulations (14 CCR) §15301: Existing Facilities;
- Class 8 exemption, 14 CCR §15308: Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment; and
- Class 30 exemption, 14 CCR §15330: Minor Actions to Prevent, Minimize, Stabilize, Mitigate or Eliminate the Release or Threat of Release of Hazardous Waste or Hazardous Substances.
