Description (Continued from page 1)

Office of Electrical, Mechanical, Water, and Wastewater Engineering (EMWW) staff assessed the site and concluded the existing generator is not operational and will not be able to support the facility during power outage. The existing generator system must be replaced immediately. This project is needed to avoid failure or threat of failure to the transportation system, which can result in the loss or impairment of life, health, or property.

The scope of work includes remove and dispose existing generator, dispose fuel inside existing bulk fuel tank; provide design plan, install spare generator with new automatic transfer switch, upgrade electrical system, and incidental work.

Right-of-Way

All work is anticipated to occur at the CHP Donner Pass Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Facility.

Borrow/Disposal

It is anticipated that a borrow site will not be required.

Consultation/Coordination

Based on the scope of work and due to the nature of the project, consultation or coordination was not required.

Permits

Based on the scope of work, regulatory permits were not required.

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
