## NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

**PROJECT TITLE:** Big Basin Redwoods Headquarters Interim CZU Improvements

LOCATION: Big Basin Redwoods State Park COUNTY: Santa Cruz

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** On August 15, 2020, the CZU Lightening Complex fire destroyed all structures at the Big Basin Redwoods State Park entrance. Since the fire, State Route (Hwy) 236 through the park has been completely closed to the public. However, Caltrans is requiring that State Parks reopen the highway by June 2022 and temporary improvements are needed to accommodate its reopening. This project proposes to install temporary facilities necessary to reopen the park, initially on a reservation system. Work will:

- Install a temporary entry kiosk at the intersection of Hwy 236 and North Escape Rd;
- Install an interpretive center/trailer on the former site of the Nature Lodge Museum & Store;
- Install temporary restroom facilities in an existing parking lot along the east side of North Escape Road and construct a redwood screen around the toilets;
- Backfill excavated building foundations, including those of the former Park Headquarters & Visitor Center and restore the areas to a more natural condition;
- Remove approximately 800 square feet of asphalt pavement to provide for expanded root zones and more natural conditions; and
- Install two (2) pipe gates on North Escape Road, one just north of the proposed kiosk and the second just north of the entrance to the (existing) Phase 2 interim parking lot. Each gate will require excavation of two (2) approximately 12" diameter x 36" deep post holes.
