NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Public Resources Code Section 21092 and Cal. Code of Regulations Title 14, Section 15072 (the Guidelines for the California Environmental Quality Act) require a local agency to provide a notice of intent to adopt a negative declaration or mitigated negative declaration to the public, responsible agencies, trustee agencies, and the county clerk of each county within which the proposed project is located, sufficiently prior to adoption by the lead agency of the negative declaration or mitigated negative declaration to allow the public and agencies the review period provided under Section 15105 of the Guidelines.

Project Title: Getty Center Parking Improvement Project

Project Location: 1200 N. Getty Center Drive, Los Angeles, California 90049

Project Description: The Getty Center Parking Improvement Project proposes two new landscaped surface parking areas providing up to 217 vehicle parking spaces and a new 250 square-foot restroom station. The Project Site is located on two existing, previously-graded pads adjacent to the I-405 Freeway and north of the Getty Center Drive entrance. The Project Site will be improved with water conveyance infrastructure, fire hydrants, drought tolerant landscaping, and security lighting. Approximately 3,500 cubic yards of earthwork consisting of 1,400 cubic yards of soil export and 2,100 cubic yards of soil import are proposed. No protected trees are located on the Project Site.

Schedule: The City of Los Angeles will receive comments on the proposed mitigated negative declaration beginning April 21, 2022 for 30 days, ending May 23, 2022. The City of Los Angeles, as lead agency, will make a determination on the project, following a public hearing to be scheduled.
