

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has prepared an Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration (IS/ ND) for the State Route (SR) 12 Boas Drive Intersection Safety Project (Project) in the City of Santa Rosa



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED

Caltrans proposes to install traffic signals and construct pedestrian facilities, including crosswalks, at the SR 12/Boas Drive/South Boas Drive intersection. The purpose of the Project is to reduce the number and severity of accidents and to improve pedestrian safety and traffic operations at the intersection. The Project also includes reconstruction of curbs, gutters, and sidewalks, drainage improvements and new retaining walls.
