<u>Description</u> - A General Plan Amendment, Planned Unit Development, Site Plan and Tentative Parcel Map with an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration to allow for the development of mixed-use commercial and residential development on an approximately 34 acre project site that includes approximately 230,632 sq. ft. of commercial, retail, office, self-storage and restaurants on the approximately 16 acre southern half of the site; 376 multi-family residential units on the remaining northern half of the site; and the redesign of 19 parcels into 18 parcels via Tentative Parcel Map No. 20402.

<u>Location</u> - North of and abutting Bear Valley Road between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue (APN No. 3091-221-03 through 3091-221-10 & 3091-221-12 through 3091-221-21)

The proposed mixed-use development will not create any significant impacts with the included mitigation measures as proposed.
