The Project would replace the Real McCoy Ferry's deteriorating timber fender system with a new steel pile fender system; replace the boat ramps with new concrete approach slab ramps that would accommodate larger vehicles, including commercial and emergency vehicles, and extend the ferry boat deck to improve vehicle access on and off the ferry.
