Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The University Avenue Housing Project involves construction and operation of a 30-unit apartment building at 910 University Avenue, which is currently vacant. The new building, which would be located east of the Sacramento State main campus, across the American River near the Guy West Bridge, would support living space for Sacramento State faculty and staff.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Based on the findings of the Initial Study, the project would have either no impact or a less-than-significant impact related to most of the issue areas identified in the Environmental Checklist, included as Appendix G of the State CEQA Guidelines. These include the following issue areas: Aesthetics, Agriculture and Forest Resources, Air Quality, Energy, Geology/Soils, Greenhouse Gas Emissions and Climate Change, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Land Use/Planning, Mineral Resources, Population/Housing, Public Services, Recreation, Transportation, Tribal Cultural Resources, Utilities/Service Systems; and Wildfire Hazard.

Potentially significant impacts were identified for air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, noise, and tribal cultural resources; however, mitigation measures included in the IS/MND would reduce all impacts to a less-than-significant level.
