PROJECT TITLE: Natural Resources Office

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** This project seeks to relocate and rehabilitate an unused modular building and generator in Mount Diablo State Park to establish office space for the expanding Natural Resources Program staff. Work will:

- Use a skip loader and roller to prepare a 100-ft-long x 60 ft wide x 6 in. gravel pad;
- Use a backhoe to excavate one (1) 2-ft x 75 ft trench for utility installations, and once installations are complete, backfill with excavated material;
- Use a hand auger to install 4 vertical earthquake tie downs 30 inches deep;
- Pour 2 (two) 7-ft-long x 4-ft-wide x 18 in. thick concrete pads for generator installations;
- Pour an 8 in. long x 3 ft wide x 18 in. thick concrete propane pad; and
- Set the modular building on the new gravel pad and complete interior improvements as needed.
