## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kings County Community Development Agency invites public review and comment on the environmental document listed below. The public review period begins on May 13, 2022, and ends on June 13, 2022. Written comments concerning the adequacy of the documents will be accepted until 5:00 P.M. on June 13, 2022, at the Kings County Community Development Agency, at the Kings County Government Center, Engineering Building No. 6, 1400 W. Lacey Boulevard, Hanford, CA 93230. The documents are posted in the County Clerk's office and are also available at the Kings County Community Development Agency. ### INITIAL STUDY PROPOSED AS MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION:

1. **Conditional Use Permit No. 22-01 (Utica Avenue Solar Project)** – The applicant is proposing to establish a utility-scale photovoltaic solar facility with a generating capacity of 3 MW to be constructed on approximately 29 acres, located on the south side of Utica Avenue approximately, Assessor's Parcel Number 026-200-010.

The Kings County Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider the environmental document for the proposed project that is listed above. The public hearing will be tentatively held on Monday, July 11, 2022, at 7:00 P.M., in the Kings County Board of Supervisors Chambers, in the Administrative Building No. 1, Kings County Government Center, 1400 W. Lacey Blvd., Hanford, California. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 65009, subdivision (b), if you challenge Conditional Use Permit (CUP) No. 22-01 (Utica Avenue Solar Project) in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Kings County Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Interested parties are invited to appear and present evidence or make statements of fact regarding the proposed projects.
