DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to change a widely accepted user-created social trail at Henry W. Coe State Park, into an "official" park trail alignment. Work will:

- Use weed whips and hand tools to widen the current social trail from approximately 3 feet wide to 4 feet wide for approximately 500 feet and scatter brushed materials on site;
- Use a post hole digger to excavate one (1) 12-inch diameter x 36-inch deep hole;
- Insert one (1) 4x4 redwood post and back fill with excavated material to secure; and
- Attach directional arrows and a trail name sign to post.
