#### **Description** (Continued from page 1)

The scope of work includes removal of trees and debris downstream of concrete apron, backfill large cavity under existing concrete apron with grouted rock slope protection (RSP), place loose RSP in the channel, line the channel banks near culvert with concreted RSP, excavate and place grouted RSP upstream of structure, restore fencing, and incidental work.

## Right-of-Way

Staging and work occurred outside the State right-of-way. A temporary construction easement was needed for the project.

#### Consultation/Coordination

Based on the scope of work and due to the nature of the project, consultation or coordination was not required.

#### **Permits**

No permits required. A 1610 Lake and Streambed Alteration Notification from the CDFW was required for the temporary work within Nye Creek and installation of soil stabilization materials.

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
