
Notice of Intent to Adopt a MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION and OPPORTUNITY for a VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING

(Study Results Available)

Do you want a virtual public hearing on changes proposed for the State Route 154 Drainage Improvement Project in Santa Barbara County?

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from May 20, 2022 to June 17, 2022. If there are no major comments or requests for a virtual public meeting, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.



WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to rehabilitate existing drainage systems on State Route 154 in Santa Barbara County from post mile 0.0 to post mile 32.8. The project would rehabilitate several storm drain culverts; these culverts would either be repaired or replaced. At some culvert outlets, rock slope protection would be added where none currently exist. The project would also rehabilitate the Rancho Cielo (Cold Springs) Vista Point on State Route 154 by providing a hot mix asphalt overlay to the existing driveway and parking lot. Project activities would involve vegetation clearing, vegetation replanting, temporary construction access, temporary construction staging sites, temporary traffic control, pavement repaving, and pavement restriping.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you an opportunity to request a virtual public hearing.
