The approximately 443–acre North Tustin Specific Plan is proposed to revitalize existing auto-oriented retail commercial centers along North Tustin Avenue to meet shifting consumer preferences for more experiential, walkable settings. The EIR will analyze the potential environmental effects of projected buildout of up to approximately 2.1 million square feet of total commercial development, including approximately 1.9 million square feet of retail commercial uses, 138,000 square feet of office uses, 118,000 square feet of hotel uses (267 rooms); 4,211 residential units; and 101,112 square feet of public, quasi-public and institutional uses within the Specific Plan Area.
