The City of Santee (City) proposes a comprehensive Santee Cannabis Business Ordinance (Ordinance or project) amending the City's Municipal Code to regulate cannabis land uses consistent with the Medicinal and Adult-Use of Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA) and the Control, Tax, and Regulate the Adult Use of Marijuana Act (AUMA). The Ordinance would implement the provisions of the MAUCRSA to accommodate the needs of people with medical illnesses who need cannabis for medicinal purposes as recommended by their healthcare providers and to provide access to those resources. It would also provide access to adult-use cannabis for people aged 21 and over as authorized by the AUMA while imposing sensible regulations on the use of land to protect City residents, neighborhoods, and businesses from disproportionately negative impacts. The Ordinance would regulate the commercial cultivation, processing, manufacturing, testing, sale, delivery, and distribution of cannabis and cannabis products in a responsible manner to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City and to enforce rules and regulations consistent with state law and in a fair and equitable manner. Cannabis facilities would not be located within 900 feet of sensitive receptors, including kindergarten through 12th grade schools, commercial daycare centers, youth centers, religious locations, or parks. It is anticipated that certain types of cannabis facilities would only be allowed in the Light Industrial (IG), and General Commercial (GC) zones in the City, subject to the City's siting requirements. The project does not propose any specific new development; however, it would allow cannabis facilities to be permitted in the City, consistent with the fordinance.
