The Project consists of construction of a centralized treatment facility (CTF) located at the City's Operations Service Center for disinfection, fluoridation, and PFAS treatment of the City's groundwater; and the rehabilitation and/or replacement of three well facilities. The Project also includes installation of approximately 5,200 feet of piping to convey raw groundwater from the well facilities to the CTF; and upsizing 1,600 feet of treated water distribution main to allow City treated groundwater to be distributed from a centralized location.
