The California Geological Survey (CGS) has received a Notice of Preparation for an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the City of San Ramon General Plan 2040 and Climate Action Plan Update. This email conveys the following recommendations from CGS concerning geologic issues related to the project area:

1. <u>Liquefaction and Landslide Hazards</u>

The CGS is in the process of drafting zones of required investigation for liquefaction and landsliding that will include the planning area. Once Preliminary Seismic Hazard Zone Reports (SHZR) and Earthquake Zone of Required Investigation Maps (EZRIM) are completed, they will be sent to all affected lead agencies for review and comment. If Official SHZR and EZRIM are not available prior to completion of the City's General Plan update, the CGS recommends the City provide a reference to the following website, which maintains up-to-date maps of all zones of required investigation:
